SIGNIFICNT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES TO CONSOLIDATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YER ENDED 31.03.2024.

I. BACKGROUND :-

Watershed Support Services and Activities Network (WASSAN) engaged in supporting programs in the area of Water Conservation and Preservation, Innovations in Agricultural activities and Natural resources.

Watershed Support Services and Activities Network (WASSAN) Registered U/s 12AA of the Income tax Act, 1961 vide Certificate No. H.Qrs.-II/12A&80G/187/2000-01 and the same has been renewed U/s 12A vide Unique Registration Number AAATW0306PE20036 dated 24.09.2021.

Watershed Support Services and Activities Network (WASSAN) Registered U/s 80G of the Income tax Act, 1961 vide Unique Registration Number AAATW0306P22HY01 dated 17.01.2023.

Watershed Support Services and Activities Network (WASSAN) Registered under the FCRA vide No 010230551 dated 22.01.2003 and Renewed on 20.12.2021 for a period of 5 years with effect from 01.01.2022 vide Registration No.010230551.

II. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES TO ACCOUNTS

1. Basis of Preparation :-

The Financial Statements have been prepared and presented under the historical cost convention on Cash basis of Accounting except for Interest Income and Audit Fees and comply with mandatory Accounting Standards ("AS") prescribed by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India to the extent applicable.

The Financial Statements have been prepared after the consolidation of books of accounts for Local and FCRA to comply with various applicable laws.

2. Revenue Recognition:-

- a) Donations on receipt basis.
- b) Interest income from Banks as and when accrued taken to Income and Expenditure account.
- c) Restricted Grants are treated as trust funds for execution of Project, unrestricted funds are taken to Income and Expenditure account on receipt basis.

3. Fixed Assets and Depreciation:-

- a) The Fixed Assets have been capitalized at Acquisition cost along with all identifiable Expenditure incurred to bring the Asset in to the present condition.
- b) Expenditure on Leased Project properties towards renovation, maintenance and Infra Development is shown as Project Revenue.
- c) Depreciation is charged at the rates prescribed under the Income tax Act, 1961.

4. Employee Benefits :-

a) Provident Fund:

Eligible Employees receive benefits from a Provident Fund, which is a Defined Benefit plan. Both the Employees and Trust make monthly contributions to the Provident Fund plan equal to the specified percentage of the covered Employees Salary.

b) Employees State Insurance Scheme:
